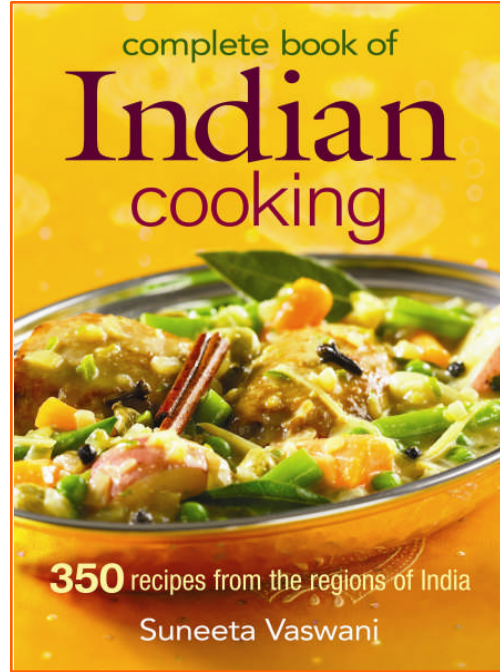


Asia Society Texas Center
